Mandatory course through 'Constitution of India' & "Professional Ethics"

Constitution of India and coherence with constitutional values, rights and duties are one of the major focuses of the Institution. Adherence to the Constitutional rights and duties is maintained through several initiatives such inclusion of separate **mandatory course through 'Constitution of India' & "Professional Ethics"** for all students in their semester studies.

Student Induction Program

The Student Induction Program is conducted for the first year students. These Orientation Programs are designed and organized with an objective to sensitize students about –

- Academic Rules and Regulations
- Campus Living
- Hostel System
- Students Club Activities, Co-curricular activities
- Group Learning, Team Spirit
- Training & Placement activities
- Counselling Systems etc.

Special sessions are also planned on

- Sports/PT/Yoga/Meditation to make them aware about Physical Fitness.
- Career Counselling, Professional Ethics and Motivation from external speakers.
- Lectures, videos and practical sessions on "Universal Human Values".

About 10% of the faculty members have been imparted training through a FDP specially designed and sponsored by AICTE.

Apart from working towards academic excellence, the institute strives to develop students as responsible citizens. Through various programs, students & employees are sensitized about constitutional obligations. Lectures, seminars are conducted for students and staff to provide the information of constitutional obligations, values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens by the Institute. National days are celebrated in the Institute with full enthusiasm.

SLIET Electoral Literacy Club

Electoral Literacy Club is active in the institute, to arrange awareness on current issues like Electoral Reforms among students and staff.

Social Activities by NSS/NCC

Students are motivated to donate and help needy persons/under privileged persons. NSS/NCC unit of the institute arranges health camps, blood donation camps, Swachatha Abhiyan, literacy drives, social responsibilities awareness camps, national integration, and social harmony etc. Students are involved in such activities as volunteers to realize their duties and responsibilities.

Specific programs initiated/arranged by the institute in past are given below:

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA):

To sensitize students about their social obligation, Institute has adapted eight villages under UBA, the Flagship Program of GoI, namely (i) Bahadurpur, (ii) Longowal, (iii) Duggan, (iv) Shahpur, (v) Jharron, (vi) Loha Khera, (vii) Mander Kalan, (viii) Kila Bharian. Institute is working for the development of these villages. Activities as listed below are planned from time to time.

- Awareness about Healthy Lifestyle
- Awareness about Swachhta Abhiyan, Social Evils, Water Conservations, Save Environment
- Awareness about Organic Farming, etc

Blood Donation Camps:

Blood donation camps in the campus at frequent intervals in which students and faculty members actively participate.
